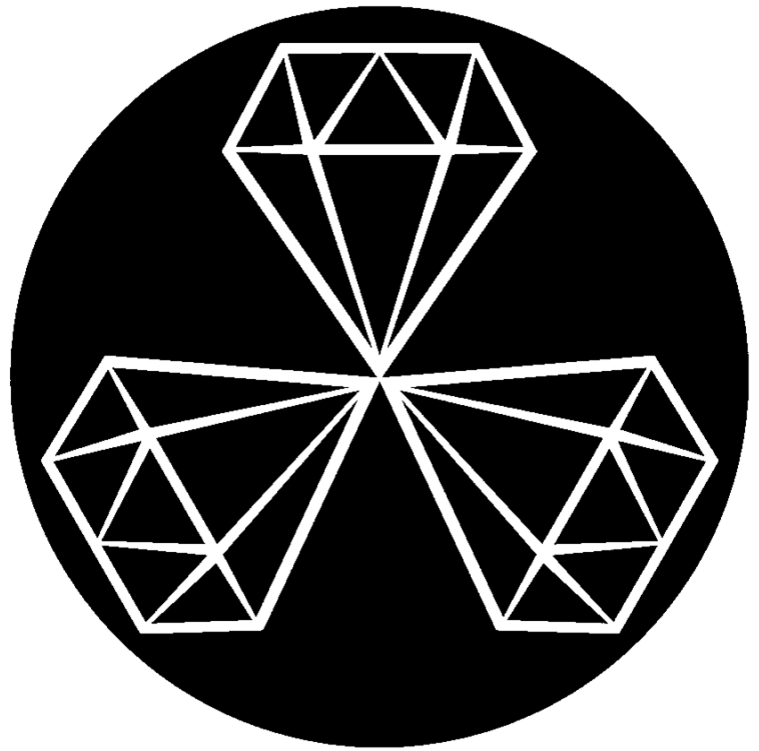


# REFUGE RECOVERY
